OCCIDENTAL

Occidental is Steve Kistler's pinot noir project with a singular focus: to make world-class pinot noir from unique sites on the headlands in the Freestone-Occidental area of the Sonoma Coast. Steve founded Occidental as a small family brand in 2011, and built a state-of-the-art winery overlooking the Pacific Ocean; the 85 acres of vineyards represent the westernmost edge of where pinot noir can be successfully grown in California.

• Grape(s):

100% estate-grown pinot noir; all vineyards are certified sustainable.

• Winemaking:

Grapes harvested at night for optimum acidity. Malolactic fermentation in stainless steel tanks. Only free-run juice is used for the wine; Occidental does not own a press and sells its remaining must to neighboring wineries. The juice is transferred to French oak barrels (30% new) where it ages for a year before bottling.

• Profile:

Lithe, snazzy, and seductive. Brightly aromatic with inviting red fruit, brambly herbs, and lively acidity. For all its showiness, it finishes with precision and a savory mineral edge.
