Templeton Rye	2oz
Averna Amaro	.5 oz
MacNut Orgeat	.5oz
Tiki Bitters	2 dashes

Assembly: Add Rye, Averna & Orgeat into a mixing glass. Add scoop of cubed ice. Stir 36 times. Strain into Riedel bucket over large Merriman's ice cube. Add 2 dashes of Tiki Bitters. Garnish with orange peel.

Description: This cocktail is Merriman's take on a Black Manhattan. The Averna Amaro is used in place of sweet vermouth. The MacNut Orgeat adds a tropical spin.

What does Pu'u Keka'a mean?: This is the Hawaiian name for Black Rock. It translates to "the turning point hill." The location represented the transition between our world and the spiritual world.
